## Draft Gas Transmission Access Code (GTAC) released.

Following the release of selected sections of the Gas Transmission Access Code (GTAC) in May 2017, First Gas has today released a complete draft of the GTAC. It is available [here](#), along with a presentation summary that provides context for the drafting, and the draft template receipt point interconnection agreements (ICAs). First Gas intends to release the draft template delivery point interconnection agreement next week.

Our 4 August 2017 News Bulletin set out the process First Gas will follow for engagement on the draft GTAC. That process commences on Thursday, 17 August, with a workshop at Gas Industry Co offices where First Gas will talk through the purpose and content of each section of the GTAC and invite discussion. That session will be facilitated by Toby Stevenson from Sapere. First Gas is also proposing to use a web-based forum (Trello) to streamline communication and collaboration on the draft GTAC. Further information on how to access and use this web forum will be provided to stakeholders next week at the workshop.
