Revision to consultation timetable on 8 December 2017 GTAC.

In Gas Industry Co's 11 December 2017 News Bulletin, we invited stakeholders to provide submissions to Gas Industry Co to assist our assessment of whether the Gas Transmission Access Code (GTAC) that First Gas Limited submitted on 8 December 2017 is materially better than the current terms and conditions of access to and use of the gas transmission pipelines.

Our indicative timetable for the GTAC assessment process was as follows:

Process	Date
Stakeholders provide submissions to Gas Industry Co on the final GTAC submitted to Gas Industry Co on 8 December 2017. Gas Industry Co seeks stakeholders' views on whether the GTAC is or isn't materially better than the existing arrangements, and reasons why	Monday, 15 January 2018
Gas Industry Co issues its preliminary assessment of the new GTAC for consultation with stakeholders	Friday, 2 February 2018
Stakeholders provide submissions to Gas Industry Co on the preliminary assessment of the new GTAC	Friday, 2 March 2018
Gas Industry Co issues its final assessment (termed a "final determination" in the MPOC)	Friday, 23 March 2018

We have considered feedback from stakeholders on that timetable, and we have decided to extend the date by which submissions on the final GTAC must be provided to Gas Industry Co until **Monday 22 January 2018**. A number of stakeholders requested a longer period for submissions on the final GTAC. After considering those requests, we concluded that a longer period would provide little additional benefit given that stakeholders will be able to provide further information regarding their views on the GTAC as part of their submissions on Gas Industry Co's preliminary assessment.

We are currently liaising with our Independent Directors regarding the indicative dates for the remainder of the timetable.
