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GTAC Preliminary Assessment Paper submissions workshop.

Gas Industry Co plans to hold a submissions workshop on **Tuesday, 27 March 2018**. The purpose of the workshop is to enable stakeholders and Gas Industry Co to consider submissions on the Preliminary Assessment Paper and to ask questions about those submissions. It should provide a useful start to preparing cross-submissions.

Gas Industry Co will begin the workshop with an overview of submitters' responses, highlighting the main points of contention. The length and format of the remainder of the workshop will depend on the number of submitters who elect to speak to their submissions. We envisage that we will allot each presenter up to 20 minutes to present the main points of their submission, plus 10 minutes to answer questions. We encourage all submitters to present, as it will provide an opportunity for you to emphasise the points you consider most important and to answer questions that others may have about your views.
