

## NOTICE OF BREACH

### Contact details of party reporting alleged breach:

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### Name of participant that is alleged to have breached the rules:

Nova Gas (GNVG)

### Rule/s allegedly breached:

Gas (Downstream Reconciliation) Rules 2008

r32.1: Actual daily energy quantities are to be provided to the allocation agent for allocation groups 1 and 2.

### Circumstances relating to the alleged breach:

Under rule 32.1, consumption information provided to the allocation agent on business day 9 should be the actual daily energy quantities for each consumer installation in allocation groups 1 and 2.

Under rule 30.3.1, if a retailer is unable to provide actual daily consumption, they must estimate the data, and advise the allocation agent.

Under rule 30.3.2, compliance with rule 30.3.1 does not mean the retailer has complied with the requirement to provide actual daily energy quantities.

Nova Gas (GNVG) submitted estimated TOU consumption data at gas gates Belmont BEL24510, Henderson HEN74101, New Plymouth NPL12101, Papakura PAP06610 and Westfield WST03610 for the interim July 2009 consumption month. The (confidential) file attached shows the estimated data.

Because the July 2009 interim allocation was published with estimated data from Nova Gas at these gas gates, the allocation agent believes this is an alleged breach of rule 32.1.
